

# Echo Mesa Men's Golf Club

## Board of Director' Minutes

May 14, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 PM by President Mick Waas. Members present were Chris Hansen, Irv Glorit, Ben Carlozzo, Ken Skinner, Dick Anderson. Nancy Hewes, Club Monitor, was also present.

Ken moved and Chris seconded that the minutes of the April 9 meeting be approved as printed.

Irv presented the Treasurer's report. The checking account balance as of April 30, 2013 was \$3,818.30. The club membership remains at 163.

The Red, White, and Blue Tournament will be on June 12 and the grounds crew needs to be informed.

Mick passed out some modifications to the SCW Recreation Center Rules, Regulations, and Procedures Manual. No actions necessary by EMMGC Board.

All charter clubs are required to follow IRS guidelines regarding tax exempt status. This may impact Club membership application forms for new, renewal and transfer members and whether annual dues need to be broken down into individual components, such as dues and handicap fees. Mick will be attending the Golf Council meeting this week for more information.

The EMMGC Board members have been informed of an individual who has not been following U.S.G.A. Rules during league play. This person has been observed playing ahead of his golf partners, putting out with the pin in the hole, taking "gimmees" etc. After discussion Dick moved, Irv seconded that a letter be sent to this person with copies to his playing partners, notifying them that required rules need to be followed or face disqualification from any Club tournaments, "sweeps" and "blind bogey" competition. When playing partners sign the official score card, they in effect approve and support the rules violations and place themselves into disqualification jeopardy. Motion passed.

Some Club members have requested that during league play consideration be given to playing Holes #4 and #17 from the red tees to speed up play. Further discussion on this recommendation was tabled to this fall.

Nancy asked the Board to decide on how to schedule play during the summer months when we are sharing the course with other clubs. The choice would be whether we alternate tee times with the other club(s) or have shotgun starts at 7:00 and 11:00 AM. Since Desert Trails plans to go with alternate tee times it was decided we should do the same.

Meeting was adjourned at 3:10 PM.
